The following questions relate to the PG&E Independent Monitor Report of November 19, 2021, Kirkland & Ellis LLP, filed on November 23, 2021 (the Monitor's 2021 report),¹ and PG&E's responses to Data Request CalAdvocates-PGE-2022WMP-06, dated January 10 and 14, 2022.

QUESTION 06

What date does PG&E define as the start of the 2021 fire season?²

ANSWER 06

PG&E does not internally define the start of the fire season, and did not do so in 2021. PG&E does utilize data provided by Cal Fire regarding burn status/fire risk to inform work schedules, but burn status/fire risk is not uniform throughout PG&E's service territory and varies based on factors specific to different areas.
