RE: Notice of Filing an Application for Authorization from the California Public Utilities Commission to Construct the Egbert Switching Station Project

Enclosed is a Notice of Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) Egbert Switching Station Project (formerly known as the Martin Bus 230 kV Extension Project), which is needed to improve transmission system reliability and ensure safe and reliable electric service to the San Francisco Peninsula. The notice contains information about the project as required by the California Public Utilities Commission.

The California Public Utilities Commission requires that PG&E give this notice to all owners of land within 300 feet of the proposed project. Please carefully review the attached notice for a description of the project.
