

Checklist for completing the Interconnection Agreement for Net Energy Metering for Residential and Small Commercial Solar or Wind Electric Generating Facilities of 10 Kilowatts or Less (Form 79-854, Revised 11/6/03)

Section 1, Page 1	Current Acct No.	Customer or Customer's Contractor completes	
Section 1, Page 1	Project Identification Number	Leave blank – PG&E will issue number	
Section 1, Page 1	Table 1, Generator Information	Customer or Customer's Contractor completes	
Section 1, Page 2	Site Address / Facility's Operational Date	Customer or Customer's Contractor completes (This is the address of the generating facility)	
Section 1, Page 2	Permit Date	Customer or Customer's Contractor completes (If the Building Permit for the generator was issued before Jan 1, 2003 enter the date the permit was issued; Otherwise leave blank)	
Section 2, Page 2	Customer Billing and Payment Options	Customer must select a rate schedule	
Section 3, Page 3	Notices	Customer or Customer's Contractor completes (This is the mailing address of the customer)	
Section 5, Page 4	Signatures	Customer of Record completes and signs. Only original signatures accepted. Note: to avoid a processing delay, the name and signature on the agreement must match the name on the Customer's PG&E service account.	

Note: The term "Customer" within the Interconnection Agreement refers to "Customer-Generator."
