Eligible pumps include those for production agriculture, landscape or turf irrigation, and municipal potable or tertiary treated water. *Once retrofitted, inefficient pumps typically get improved water throughput for the energy they consume. Energy savings between 20 to 35% are typical as pumping customers are able to reduce the hours of operation required to pump water.*
