Maximizing a home's energy efficiency could save money and energy.

That's why the City of Fresno, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, and Richard Heath and Associates, Inc. (RHA) are joining forces to deliver an energy-efficiency program designed specifically for single- and multi-family home residents in Fresno's Enterprise Zone.

By participating in the Fresno Energy Savings Alliance, eligible residential customers may save energy and money in their own home while providing significant environmental and energy benefits for all Californians.

Single-Family and Multi-Family Home energy-efficiency Direct Install Program and Additional Services

At-A-Glance

Energy-efficiency experts from RHA, Inc., will canvass designated neighborhoods in the Fresno Enterprise Zone and identify single- and multi-family homes that qualify for the installation of a variety of free energy-efficient measures. Eligible single-family home residents may also receive a free energy analysis that can help them identify how they are using their energy and ways to save.

Eligibility Requirements

RHA, Inc. will contact residents in Fresno's Enterprise Zone to identify single-family homes and multi-family properties with more than four units that can benefit from the installation of selected energy-efficient products. Special emphasis will be placed on working with moderate-income customers, California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) participants, and senior citizens. Customers can call RHA, Inc. at 1.559.447.7012 and request that their address be considered for this program.

Eligible Equipment

Energy-efficient products that may be installed in qualifying single-family and multi-family residences include:

- ☞ ENERGY STAR® compact fluorescent lamps
- ☞ ENERGY STAR interior and exterior hardwired fluorescent lighting fixtures
- ☞ ENERGY STAR programmable thermostats
- ☞ Water faucet aerators
- ☞ Low-flow showerheads
- ☞ T-8 interior fluorescent lamps
- ☞ Reflector-type light bulbs (for multi-family only)

Energy-efficient products that may be installed in the common areas of qualifying multi-family properties include:

- ☞ LED exit signs
- ☞ T-5 or T-8 fluorescent interior lamps
- ☞ ENERGY STAR programmable thermostats

Duct testing and sealing may also be performed.

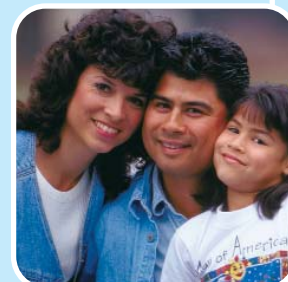
Program Timeline

Additional Services

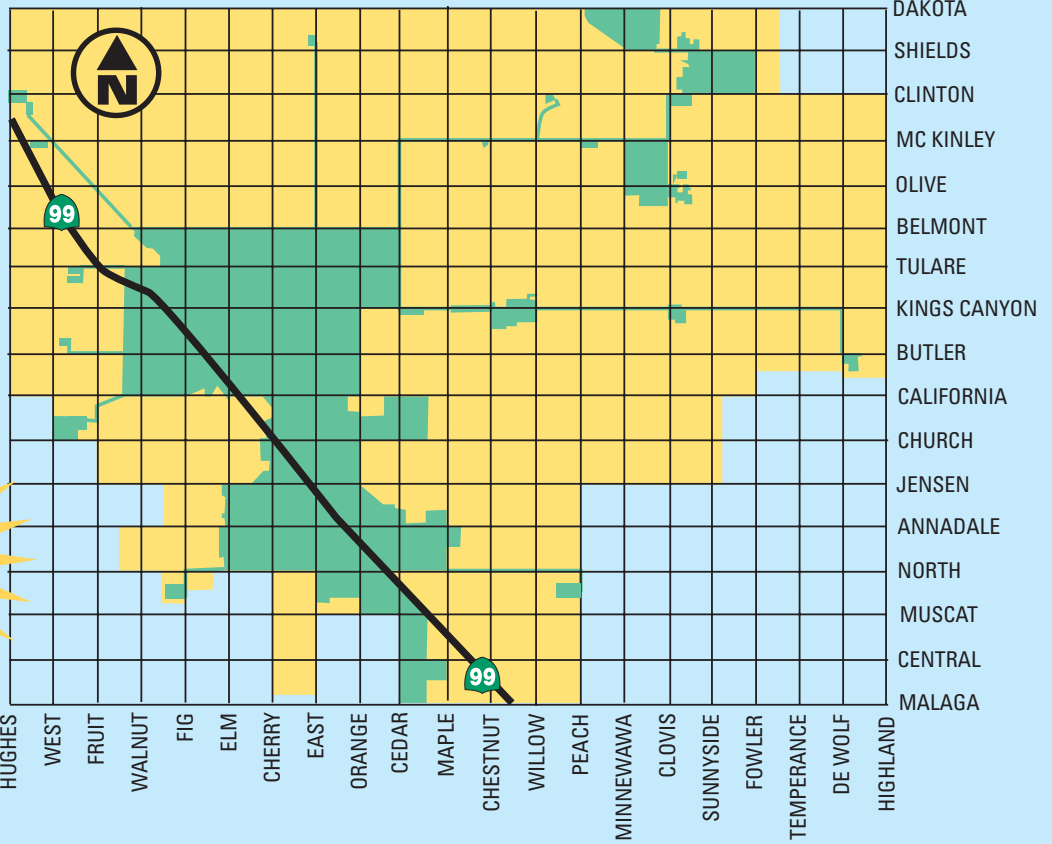
