The California Energy Commission in partnership with Pacific Gas and Electric Company will be conducting a New Solar Homes Partnership (NSHP) workshop on July 8, 2010. This is a great opportunity for builders, solar retailers and installers to learn more about the NSHP documentation requirements, and the NSHP web-based application tool in order to participate in the NSHP.

The NSHP is a ten-year, \$400 million solar program which provides incentives, encouraging the purchase and installation of photovoltaic (PV) solar systems on new, energy-efficient homes built in California.

This workshop will be taught by staff members of the California Energy Commission and will include:

- NSHP Guidebook Version 3 changes adopted on January 27th, 2010
- Application process, reservation and required documents
- NSHP energy efficiency requirements
- Payment process
- Online web tool – submitting applications electronically
- NSHP CECPV calculator
