Subject: PG&E - EDI DACRS/PCIA Communication

Trading Partners,

PG&E has reached an agreement with various parties on Direct Access Cost Responsibility Surcharge (DACRS) in the context of the Direct Access Suspension Proceeding (R. 02-11-011). Effective September 1, 2006, the following changes will be made to the Direct Access Cost Responsibility Surcharge (DACRS):

- (a) DACRS will no longer be capped at 2.7 cents/kWh but will be based on the sum of 4 components (DWR Bond Charge, Power Cost Indifference Adjustment, Ongoing Competition Transition Costs (CTC) and Energy Recovery Bond).
- (b) the "DWR Power Charge" will be replaced with "Power Charge Indifference Adjustment" (see the EDI invoice illustration below).
- (c) The Power Charge Indifference Adjustment may be a positive or negative value.

The following change will occur in your EDI invoice beginning September 1, 2006:

From

To

SAC|N| |EU|MSC044|16962| | |0|KH|0| | | |Power Charge Indifference Adjustment^

This PCIA will have the same applicability as the DWR Power Charge (e.g. CARE, medical and/or continuous DA customers were exempted from DWR Power Charge and they will continue to be exempted from PCIA). In addition, PCIA may be a positive or negative.
