This summer as the temperatures and demand for electricity soared, so, too, did monthly utility bills. The unprecedented heat storm was a draw on every utility system in California, including our own. Because of the unprecedented nature of the heat storm, from July 16 to July 27, 2006, PG&E is giving its residential customers a 15 percent credit off of their July electric charges. Our business, governmental, commercial and agricultural customers will receive a 10 percent credit. This Heat Storm Bill Credit will appear on customers' October bills.
