



Welcome to Fluor Outage Hiring

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE:

Please submit an Electronic Personal History Questionnaire (ePHQ) up to three weeks prior to your in-processing date, but no later than the day after you have received your dispatch.

Select the ePHQ link/description (found on the Microsite Home page) that corresponds to the last time you held unrestricted access (UA) at an operating nuclear power plant. If you do not know the date of your last favorable termination, contact the DCPD Access office by email (DLI1@pge.com or SEHM@pge.com) or phone (805-545-2692).

**** Bring the password, username and email that you use on your ePHQ in case any changes need to be made.**

NOTE: Your employment paperwork will be given to you on your first day of hire at the Energy Education Center. Please **DO NOT** complete the forms located in the PG&E Hiring Information section of the Microsite page.

FIRST DAY OF HIRE: In Processing and Human Performance/Safety Orientation with Fluor

On your first day, you will report to the Energy Education Center located at 6588 Ontario Road, San Luis Obispo. The facility will open at 0545 and we will begin at 0600.

Please bring the following items:

Work authorization documents, which include:

- Valid & current picture ID – Can include a driver's license, State issued ID card, passport, or military ID
- Social Security Card or Passport
- If not a US citizen – bring documentation
- Union dispatch and relevant craft specific qualification cards

Lunch/Snacks – there are no food or drink vending machines at this site

SECOND DAY OF HIRE: In Processing with PG&E and NANTeL Web Based Training

On your second day, you will report to our training facility located in Area 10 at the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. At this facility you will be attending PG&E In Processing and completing your NANTeL web based training courses. Please reference the Site Map that you receive at the EEC to become familiar with important facility locations. You are expected to wear appropriate "work" clothes including long pants and work boots (steel toe is not necessary). The time clocks will be located inside the Fluor Training Facility. Please clock in using the employee number provided to you on Day 1 at the EEC. Watch for the posted signs which will help guide you from Parking Lot #1 to the Fluor Training Facility.

Please bring the following items:

- Picture ID that is valid and current
- Vehicle license plate numbers, vehicle make, model, year and color
- Lunch/Snacks – there are minimal food and drink vending machines in Area 10
- If Applicable: Arrests in last 5 years – bring court papers & documents with you
- If you were a student within the last 5 years – bring an official set of your transcripts
