(Pacific Gas and Electric Company ID U 39 M)

Subject: Authorization to transfer funds from the consultant costs memorandum account to the Transition Revenue Account (TRA), Core Fixed Cost Account (CFCA) and Noncore Customer Class Charge Account (NCA)

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (the Company) hereby seeks authorization to transfer a total of \$2,071,324.47 recorded in the consultant costs memorandum account to the Transition Revenue Account (TRA) and Core Fixed Cost Account (CFCA) and Noncore Customer Class Charge Account (NCA) and close the consultant costs memorandum account. This amount is the total billed to the Company by the Commission for reimbursement of the costs of consultants retained to assist the Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA) in its analysis of and presentation in the Company's 1999 General Rate Case (GRC). This filing is made in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 19 of Decision (D.) 00-02-046 and the Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ) Ruling of June 20, 2000.

Background

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 19 of D. 00-02-046, the Company is authorized to file an advice letter for the purpose of transferring costs recorded in the consultant costs memorandum account to the respective electric and gas balancing accounts, and closing the memorandum account.

Attachment I reflects the total costs associated with the consultant costs memorandum account and the applicable interest amounts. As required in the ALJ's Ruling, Attachment I shows that the Company has fully complied with the interest requirements of Ordering Paragraph 19 of D. 00-02-046.

Upon approval of this advice letter, the Company will debit \$2,071,324.47 to the appropriate accounts. Based on the allocation between the electric and gas departments recommended by ORA in its April 17, 2000, report and the base

revenue amounts applicable to Core and Noncore gas service, the amounts to be debited to each account are:

TRA	\$1,636,346.33
CFCA	\$416,129.09
NCA	\$18,849.05

The Commission's internal audit staff is auditing the invoices from consultants retained by ORA for the 1999 GRC. If, as a result of this audit, the amounts previously billed to the Company are adjusted, the Company will file another advice letter to incorporate the adjustment in the TRA, CFCA and NCA accounts.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter within 20 days of the date of this filing. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously.
