Subject: Revisions to Program Year (PY) 2000 Low-Income Energy Efficiency (LIEE) and California Alternate Rates For Energy (CARE) Program Budgets

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (the Company) hereby submits changes to its PY 2000 LIEE and CARE Program Budgets.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to reflect changes in the Low Income Advisory Board's (LIAB) 2000 budget and increases to the Company's program budgets to cover the cost of the new studies and reports specified in Decision (D.) 00-07-020. This filing is made in compliance with D. 00-07-020, Ordering Paragraph 12, dated July 6, 2000.

Attachment A contains the revised PY2000 LIEE budget reflecting reductions in the PY 2000 LIAB budget and additions to cover the cost of the new studies and reports as ordered. Attachment B revises the PY2000 CARE budget. Increases to both the CARE and LIEE budgets include the Company's portion (30%) of the reimbursement to the Commission for six new civil positions.
