(Pacific Gas and Electric Company ID U 39 E)

Subject

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (the Company) hereby submits this supplemental advice filing revisions to Advice 2053-E dated November 7, 2000, The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

Advice 2053-E submitted new rate Schedule E-NET—*Net Energy Metering Service*, replacing Schedule E-NEM--*Net Energy Metering Service*, in compliance with the Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ) Ruling on Implementation of Assembly Bill (AB) 918 (R. 99-10-025) dated October 23, 2000. Effective January 1, 2001, Schedule E-NET will be the rate schedule applicable to net-metered customer-generators ("Customer-Generators").

Also updated in Advice 2053-E was the Interconnection Agreement for Net Energy Metering for Residential and Small Commercial Solar or Wind Electric Generating Facilities of 10 Kilowatts or Less (Interconnection Agreement) (Form 79-854), to reflect that Customer-Generators may pay their net energy consumption monthly if they choose. This filing submits a minor modification to Form 79-854 as described herein. Form 79-854 as submitted in this supplemental filing cancels and supersedes the same form filed in Advice 2053-E. No other tariff changes are submitted.

The Regional Council of Rural Counties (RCRC) submitted a timely protest letter to Advice 2053-E on November 20, 2000. RCRC had no objections to Advice 2053-E per se, but requested that PG&E clarify "non-energy charges" in Form 79-854. PG&E timely responded to RCRC's letter on November 29, 2000, proposing that if the Commission so directed, PG&E would add parenthetical language to the "Declarations" Section 2—Customer Billing and Payments Options, line 3 of the Interconnection Agreement as follows: "Customer-Generator will be billed and will be expected to pay monthly for the non-energy charges (*i.e., non-per-kilowatt-hour charges*) due under Customer-Generator's otherwise-applicable rate schedule." [clarifying language shown in italics]

The Commission's Energy Division has directed PG&E to file this supplemental filing in response to RCRC's request. In order to timely implement the E-NET tariffs effective January 1, 2001, in compliance with AB 918, Energy Division is asking the Commission's Executive Director to reduce the protest period for this supplemental filing, pursuant to Section XV General Order 96-A, as set forth below.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by electronic mail (e-mail) as described below on or before **December 27, 2000**. The protest shall be limited to the change to Form 79-854 submitted in this supplemental filing. PG&E will respond to any protest received by e-mail by **December 29, 2000**.
