Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

Subject: Report the Gain on Sale of Streetlight System to the City of Santa Rosa

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (the Company) hereby submits for filing to the Commission the gain realized from the sale of a streetlight system to the City of Santa Rosa (the City). This filing is made in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision (D.) 00-07-011, dated July 6, 2000.

Purpose:

In Application (A.) 00-01-016, filed January 12, 2000, the Company and the City requested, under Public Utilities Code § 851, to sell and convey the Company's streetlight system located in Santa Rosa to the City. The Commission approved that request in D.00-07-011.

Background:

Ordering Paragraph 3 of D.00-07-011 requires the Company to inform the Commission by advice letter the gain on sale realized from the sale of the streetlight system. Attachment I contains the gain on sale for the streetlight system. As authorized by D.00-07-011, the gain will accrue to the Company's shareholders.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with any rate schedule or rule.
