**ADVICE 2080-E**

(Pacific Gas and Electric Company)

Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

**Subject:** Report of the Gain on the Sale of Streetlight System to the Cities of Antioch and Salinas

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby reports to the Commission the gain on sale realized from the sale of two streetlight systems on to the City of Antioch and one to the City of Salinas. This filing is made in compliance with Paragraph 3 of Decision (D.) 00-02-022.

**Purpose:**

In Application (A.) 99-08-032, filed on August 13, 1999, PG&E and the Cities of Antioch and Salinas requested, under Public Utilities Code § 851, to sell and convey PG&E's streetlight systems located in Antioch and Salinas to the cities of Antioch and Salinas, respectively. The Commission approved that request in D. 00-02-022.

**Background:**

Ordering Paragraph 3 of D.00-02-022 requires PG&E to inform the Commission by advice letter, the gain on sale realized from the sales of those streetlight systems. Attachment I contains the gain on sale for each of the streetlight systems. As authorized by D.00-02-022, the gain will accrue to PG&E's shareholders.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with any rate schedule or rule.
