Subject: Update of Service Provider Lists

Purpose

As directed in Affiliate Rule IV.C.2, (Decision 98-11-007), Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby submits its semi-annual update of its lists of service providers that contain affiliates. Pacific Gas and Electric Company requests authorization to continue to offer the following lists to customers, which contains one or more affiliates of Pacific Gas and Electric Company. These lists were most recently approved effective February 8, 2001, in Advice 2286-G/2066-E.

- Super List: List of all service providers (Attachment A) which is updated monthly. This list is provided to customers or third parties requesting information about an affiliate company for which a more specific list has not been approved in accordance with Affiliate Rule IV.C.2. Parties wishing to be placed on the list must complete and submit the request form (Attachment B) to this filing;
- List of Direct Access Service Providers (Attachment C) which will be updated at least monthly;
- Natural Gas Suppliers List (Attachment D); and
- Core Transport Agent (CTA) List (Attachment E) which will be updated at least monthly.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company has removed PG&E Energy Services from all lists and has replaced it with PG&E Energy Services Ventures, Inc.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company requests that this filing be approved on regular notice, **June 11, 2001**, which is 40 days after the date of this filing.

PG&E reserves all legal rights to challenge the decisions or statutes under which it has been required to make this advice filing, and nothing in this advice filing constitutes a waiver of such rights. Also, PG&E reserves any additional legal rights to challenge the requirement to make this advice filing by reason of its status as a debtor under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, and nothing in this advice filing constitutes a waiver of such rights.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter within 20 days of the date of this filing. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously.
