**Subject: Notification of the Conveyance of Easements to Placer County
Water Agency**

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to comply with Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision (D.) 02-01-027, which requires PG&E to provide easement documents related to this transaction to the Commission.¹

The Ordering Paragraph states:

“Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is authorized to convey three easements across its property located on Merry Knoll Road to Placer County Water Agency. When the final easement documents are executed, PG&E shall submit a copy by advice letter filing within sixty (60) days of this order.”

Background

In Application (A.) 01-11-023, filed November 14, 2001, PG&E requested Commission approval, pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 851, for permission to grant easements to Placer County Water Agency, allowing them to install and maintain water system facilities on PG&E utility property. The Commission approved the request in D. 02-01-027.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with any rate schedule or rule.
