**Subject: Revisions to Special Agreement for Electrical Standby Service  
(Form 79-285)**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing, revisions to the electric tariff sheets. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.<sup>1</sup>

**Purpose**

The purpose of this filing is to provide revisions to *Special Agreement for Electric Standby* (Form 79-285).

**Background**

On October 9, 2002, the Commission's Energy Division approved Advice 2142-E-A, *Revisions to Electric Rate Schedule S-Standby*. After further review of the approved filing, under Special Condition #1, PG&E realized that the reference made to reservation capacity identifies Special Condition #8, instead of Special Condition #7. Special Condition #7 references reservation capacity. This correction in the tariff is being filed (Advice 2220-E), concurrently with this advice filing. This advice filing corrects this inadvertent typographical error in the special agreement form (Form 79-285).

In addition, in the agreement form, PG&E is deleting the explanation under "Terms and Conditions," Point 8, regarding how reservation capacity is

determined. This deletion corrects an incomplete explanation of how reservation capacity is determined. PG&E has referenced the standby tariff, which provides a complete and clear description of the determination of reservation capacity.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, nor cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.
