(Pacific Gas and Electric Company ID U39 E)**

**Subject: Notice of Proposed Construction of Facilities Pursuant to  
General Order 131-D, Tesla-Stockton Co-Gen Junction 115  
Kilovolt Power Line Relocation in the City of Ripon**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (the Company) hereby submits notice pursuant to General Order (G.O.) 131-D, Section XI, Subsection B.4 of the construction of facilities that are exempt from a Permit to Construct.<sup>1</sup>

**Purpose**

This advice letter provides a copy of the Notice of Proposed Construction (Attachment I) and the Notice Distribution List, which comply with the noticing requirements found in G.O. 131-D, Section XI, Subsections B and C.

**Background**

The developer of Montecito Estates has requested the Company to relocate a portion of the existing Tesla-Stockton Co-Gen Jct. 115 kilovolt (kV) power line in the City of Ripon, in order to widen a portion of Doak Road. A total of 5 wood poles will be affected. One pole will be relocated approximately 20 feet south, one pole will be intersert within the existing pole line, one pole will be replaced

with a taller and larger class pole and 2 poles removed. The total length of 115 kV line to be replaced during the relocation is approximately 1,674 feet. Construction is scheduled to begin in June 2002, or as soon as possible thereafter, and the new facilities are planned to be in operation in June 2002.

This project qualifies as exempt from Permit to Construct filing requirements pursuant to G.O. 131-D, Section III, Subsection B.1, which exempts, "power lines or substations to be relocated or constructed which have undergone environmental review pursuant to CEQA as part of a larger project, and for which the final CEQA document (Environmental Impact Report (EIR) or Negative Declaration) finds no significant unavoidable environmental impacts caused by the proposed line or substation".

The City of Ripon has issued a Negative Declaration dated July 18, 2000 for the Mohler Development Agreement #DA-00-3.

Additionally, G.O. 131-D requires utilities to employ "no cost" and specified "low cost" measures to reduce public exposure to electric and magnetic fields (EMFs). Based upon the standard that "low cost" mitigation measures not exceed 4% of the total project costs, there are no "no cost" or "low cost" measures to be employed by the Company on this project.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other rate schedule or rule.

### **Protests**

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by filing a protest with the CPUC and the Company by **May 14, 2002**, which is 20 days after the filing date, at the following address:

**Effective Date**

The Company requests that this advice filing become effective on **June 3, 2002**, which is 40 days after the date of filing. (In accordance with G.O. 131-D, construction will not begin until 45 days after notice is first published.)
