(Pacific Gas and Electric Company ID U 39 M)

Public Utilities Commission of the State of California

**Subject: Revised Service Planning Applications for New Construction**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to its electric and gas standard forms as follows: Application for Service - Residential Service (Form 62-0683), Application for Service - Residential Subdivision (Form 62-0684), Application for Service - Commercial Industrial Service (Form 62-0685), Application for Service - Agricultural Service (Form 62-0686).<sup>1</sup>

PG&E is also requesting approval of a new form, Form 62-0687- Application for Relocation/Rearrangement

Finally, PG&E is requesting permission to use these Applications for Service in a new, on-line Application for Service Process.

**Purpose**

Forms 62-0683, 62-0684, 62-0685 and 62-0686 are applications for new service designed to collect specific information from new single-family residential projects, residential subdivisions commercial/industrial facilities, and agricultural customers, respectively. The information will be the basis on which the physical service is designed, constructed, connected, charged for, and the basis for the rate at which the utility service is billed. The newly created Form 62-0687, *Application for Relocation/Rearrangement*, is designed to allow a more uniform and consistent method for obtaining critical information from customers requesting PG&E to relocate or rearrange service facilities.

PG&E is also modifying each form to request additional information or to inform customers of options. Modifications include:

- Additional choices to allow applicants to clearly define the type of new business project being built,
- Applicant's legal name for PG&E contract preparation,
- Detailed description of the applicant design option,
- Option for applicant to choose a bid from PG&E for design and/or construction of new gas/electric facilities,
- Clear separation of choices in construction options for installation of distribution and service facilities,
- More detailed electric and gas load information request sheet, and
- More succinctly stating the applicant's responsibilities for providing complete information, and paying for PG&E's initial evaluation and design costs.

PG&E is developing an on-line Application Process. The on-line Applications for Service will be designed to mimic these filed, hard-copy forms and will collect the same applicant information as the filed hard-copy forms. PG&E is proposing to allow applicants to fill out an application on-line and submit the application electronically. PG&E is requesting the Commission's approval to use these standard forms in an electronic format when the electronic format is completed. PG&E's use will comply with its Preliminary Statements regarding use of electronic sample forms: "Such documents may have a standardized appearance that differs from the originally-filed form; however, the form will contain the precise terms and conditions of the original on file with and approved by the Commission." (Electric and Gas Preliminary Statements at paragraph A. 5.)

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other rate schedule or rule.

### **Protests**

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter by **September 4, 2002**, which is 20 days from the date of this filing. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. Protests should be mailed to:
