(Pacific Gas and Electric Company ID U 39 E)**

Public Utilities Commission of the State of California

Subject: Consolidate Tariff Changes from Advice Letters Related to Standby Service Modifications and Special Agreement for Electric Standby Service

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for a supplemental filing revisions to its electric tariffs. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.¹

Purpose:

This filing continues consolidation of various tariff changes related to modifications to the PG&E Special Agreement for Electrical Standby Service (Form 79-285), as filed in Advice Nos. 2124-E, 2124-E-A, 2142-E, 2142-E-A, 2226-E, and 2226-E-A. In Advice 2286-E, PG&E inadvertently neglected to include Form 79-285 as part of the consolidation, since it is part of the filings listed above.

Each filing was filed and in effective at different points of time over a two-year period (2001 through 2002); thus, PG&E did not have a consolidated Form 79-285.

Advice 2124-E-A is effective May 21, 2002, pursuant to Resolution E-3777. This filing was made to comply with Resolution E-3777, which approved our proforma tariffs to Advice 2124-E and specifically related to modifying the tariffs also to

comply with Senate Bill 1X 28. This filing included modifications to Form 79-285.

Advice No. 2142-E-A was effective **July 27, 2002**, pursuant to Decision (D.) 01-07-027. Advice 2142-E-A was made to comply with D. 01-07-027, which modified the electric tariffs to include, among other things, the relationship between solar generating facilities up to 1 megawatt and standby rates. It also included Form 79-285.

Advice Nos. 2226-E and 2226-E-A were effective **May 19, 2002**. These filings also to corrected typographical errors made in the form included in Advice 2142-E-A, effective July 27, 2001.
