**Subject: DWR Bond Charge and Energy Procurement Surcharges –
Revisions to Energy Statement Back of Bill**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits this advice filing for the purpose of revising the “back of bill” language for gas and electric Standard Form 01-6330--*Energy Statement--Central Mailing*.¹ The affected tariffs are listed on Attachment I to this filing.

Background

In Advice 2364-E dated April 1, 2003, PG&E added the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) Bond Charge as a separate line item to individual electric rate schedules in accordance with Decision (D.) 02-12-082 and the requirements set forth in a letter from the Commission’s Executive Director dated February 7, 2003. Advice 2364-E-A submitted revisions to bill forms consistent with Advice 2364-E, including revised “back of bill” language for all versions of electric Form 01-6330.

Revisions to “Back of Bill” Language

The Commission’s Energy Division has requested that PG&E make certain clarifying revisions to the “back of bill” language submitted in Advice 2364-E-A for Form 01-6330. The formatted “back of bill” which applies to all versions of gas and electric Form 01-6330 is included as Attachment II to this filing. The revised language is shown in ‘strike and bold’ format as follows:

¹ PG&E reserves all legal rights to challenge the decisions or statutes under which it has been required to make this advice filing, and nothing in this advice filing constitutes a waiver of such rights. Trust Transfer Amount (TTA): A portion of ~~historic~~ costs **related to investments in electric generation facilities and purchased power contracts that were approved by the California Public Utilities Commission prior to electric industry restructuring** ~~has~~ **have** been financed through low cost-bonds to reduce your total bill by 10%. The TTA reflects the costs of these bonds, which are less expensive than the type of financing the utilities previously employed. The TTA does not offset your rate reduction, nor does it increase the total amount you otherwise would have paid. The TTA has been transferred to ~~a subsidiary of PG&E and then to~~ a public trust. PG&E is collecting the TTA on behalf of the ~~subsidiary and~~ public trust. The TTA does not belong to PG&E. Although the TTA is shown as a separate line item, it is already included in your total charges and does not increase your electricity costs.

Energy Surcharges (ES): Revenues **from these surcharges are used to fund procurement of electricity. These surcharges are listed in PG&E's tariff to** ~~supplement funding for electricity costs as provided in~~ Schedule E-EPS (**Energy Procurement Surcharge**). ~~Bundled service customers'~~ Generation Charge includes applicable energy surcharges **for customers who purchase electric power from PG&E.**

Generation Charges: For ~~bundled service~~ customers **who purchase electric power from PG&E**, this charge is established to pay for electricity using generation rates found in each rate schedule. For ~~DA~~ customers **who purchase electric power from a non-PG&E source (i.e., Direct Access customers)**, this charge consists of Direct Access Cost Responsibility Surcharge (DA-CRS) as set forth in Schedule EC.

Back of Bill for Gas Form 01-6330

By this filing, PG&E is also updating the "back of bill" language in the equivalent versions of gas Form 01-6330.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter by **July 10, 2003**, which is 20 days from the date of this filing.
