**Subject: Report on the Gain on Sale of Streetlight System Sold to the
City of Yuba City**

Purpose

In accordance with Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision (D.) 01-06-004, dated June 7, 2001, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing to the Commission its report on the gain realized from the sale of a streetlight system to the City of Yuba City (the City).¹

Background

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 851, PG&E filed Application (A.) 01-01-037 on January 25, 2001, and requested Commission approval to sell and convey PG&E's streetlight system located in Yuba City to the City. The Commission approved that request in D. 01-06-004, dated June 7, 2001. The decision included an order to report on the gain on sale of the streetlight system within 90 days of the sale and conveyance, which occurred on September 1, 2003.

Ordering Paragraph 2 states:

"Within 90 days of the sale and conveyance of the Streetlight System, PG&E shall file an advice letter to report the gain-on-sale of the Streetlight System; PG&E may accrue any such gain to its shareholders."

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter by **November 11, 2003**, which is 20 days from the date of this filing. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. Protests should be mailed to:
