Subject: Submission of Electric Rate Schedule E-DCG – *Departing Customer Generation, CG* Implementing Modifications in Accordance with Decision 05-06-041.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to its electric tariffs. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to revise electric Rate Schedule E-DCG – *Departing Customer Generation, CG* (E-DCG) to implement Commission Decision (D.) 05-06-041, *Opinion Adopting a Cost Responsibility Surcharge for County and Municipal Water District's Self-Generation*.

Background

On June 30, 2005, the Commission issued D.05-06-041, adopting a cost responsibility surcharge (CRS) applicable to county and municipal water districts' electric self-generation in the PG&E service territory. The Commission determined that the mechanism established in D.03-04-030 for determining a CRS and the applicable exceptions, shall apply to county and municipal water districts that generate their own electricity to serve both the water districts' on-site load and to their facilities load located off-site.

Tariff Revisions

PG&E has updated Schedule E-DCG in this advice filing to include county and municipal load served by self-generation as Customer Generation. Specifically, the following is added to the definition of Customer Generation:

For the purpose of applying this tariff, county and municipal water district self-generation which is used to serve the district's own loads, whether on-site or off-site, is also considered to be Customer Generation, pursuant to

Commission Decision by D.05-06-041. County and municipal water district generation serving off-site loads other than the district's own loads is not considered to be Customer Generation under this tariff, unless the service is provided over-the-fence in accordance with Public Utility Code Section 218.
