Public Utilities Commission of the State of California

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to its gas tariffs. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to delete electric Form 79-1005--*Technical Assistance Incentive Application*, originally approved in Advice 2403-E dated July 17, 2003. Decision (D.) 03-06-032 dated June 5, 2003, initiated, among other things, the Technical Assistance Incentive program for California utilities. Advice 2389-E dated June 16, 2003, was filed in compliance with that decision, modifying electric rate Schedule DBP--*Demand Bidding Program*, and introducing new electric rate Schedule CPP--*Critical Peak Pricing Program*. Both schedules referenced Form 79-1005, which originally was submitted in Advice 2403-E dated July 17, 2003.

Background

Beginning in 2003, California utilities began to provide technical assistance to customers in the form of energy audits or technical studies to help customers understand how they could best participate in Demand Response (DR) programs. The Technical Assistance (TA) Incentive program was substantially changed in D. 05-01-056 dated January 7, 2005. The original TA Incentive Program was replaced by a new TA program, including: 1) a cursory evaluation of the customer's DR potential, and 2) a free in-depth DR audit, if requested by the customer.

Advice 2623-E dated May 24, 2005, eliminated the references to Form 79-1005 in the rate schedules but did not eliminate Form 79-1005 from PG&E's Table of Contents – Standard Forms. This filing seeks to eliminate Form 79-1005, as it is no longer used for the TA Incentive Program.
