Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to Form 62-0980 -- Distribution Service and Extension Agreement Declarations.

Purpose

The purpose of this request is to seek approval for revisions to Form 62-0980 to simplify the Distribution Service and Extension Agreement and make it easier for new business applicants to understand.

Background

PG&E's Distribution Service and Line Extension Agreement contains a form entitled "Declarations," which allows the Applicant to choose who will perform particular installation work and to select either the 10 Year Refund or 50% Discount Option. This form also references applicable rules and documents that are provided to the Applicant by PG&E.

PG&E proposes to simplify this form to make it easier for customers to understand and to eliminate the requirement to automatically provide the Applicant with copies of the Rules with every New Business Job. Many Applicants have multiple projects and have indicated that they have no need to accumulate duplicative sets of the applicable rules and the general terms and conditions, and many prefer to view the information on-line. This will save more than 100 pages of paper for each agreement. Considering that PG&E enters into approximately 10,000 Distribution Service and Line Extension agreements per year, providing copies of rules and general terms and conditions only upon request will yield substantial paper savings.

PG&E proposes the following changes to Form 62-0980:

- **Section 2. Applicable Documents.** Applicants will be advised that they may obtain copies of the Rules as well as copies of the General Terms and Conditions on-line or by requesting copies from their local PG&E Representative.

- **Section 3. Construction Options.** Simplify the options to make it easier for the Applicant to understand and therefore make better informed decisions, especially regarding the division of work between PG&E and the Applicant.
- **Section 4. Refund Options.** Simplify the Section where the Applicant chooses whether to take the 10-year Refundable or the 50% Discount Option.


