Subject: Notification of the Reclassification of Two Affiliates

Purpose

In accordance with Decision 97-12-088, Appendix A, Rule VI. B--New Affiliate Compliance Plans, Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby notifies the Commission of the formation of a new affiliate, as defined by the Affiliate Transaction Rules.

Rule VI. B. Specifically requires that:

Upon creation of a new affiliate, which is addressed by these Rules, the utility shall immediately notify the Commission of the creation of the new affiliate, as well as posting notice on its electronic bulletin board. No later than 60 days after the creation of this affiliate, the utility shall file an advice letter with the Energy Division of the Commission, served on parties to this proceeding. The advice letter shall demonstrate how the utility will implement these Rules with respect to the new affiliate.

Effective August 8, 2006, PG&E Corporation changed the affiliate classification of two existing affiliates, Fuelco LLC and Pacific Energy Fuels Company (PEFCO) to Rule II.B status.

Fuelco LLC (Fuelco)

Fuelco LLC is jointly owned by Pacific Gas and Electric Company through PEFCO along with Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren UE; and TXU (Texas Utilities) Generation Company LP. Fuelco was formed to assist in transactions to secure nuclear products and services, including nuclear fuel, for use at the member utilities' nuclear power generators. Pacific Energy Fuels Company is a 33.3% partner in Fuelco LLC and was originally formed on February 18, 1988 to own and finance nuclear fuel inventory. Additional Information

On August 8, 2003, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, through PEFCO, together with Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren UE and TXU Generation (Texas Utilities) Company LP, formed Fuelco. At that time, Pacific Gas and Electric Company held a 4% interest in Fuelco through PEFCO. As of August

8, 2006, Pacific Gas and Electric Company owns a one-third interest in Fuelco through PEFCO; therefore, it is now a Rule II.B affiliate.

PEFCO was originally formed on February 18, 1988 to own and finance nuclear fuel inventory. As noted above, PEFCO now owns a one-third interest in Fuelco; therefore, it is now a Rule II.B affiliate.

No unusual or unique circumstances exist that would require affiliate transactions rule implementation measures for the affiliates listed above. The affiliate rules will apply to these affiliates other than those stated in Decision 05-09-006 dated September 8, 2005. Therefore, Pacific Gas and Electric Company will apply all the provisions of its Affiliate Rules Compliance Plan to all transactions with these Rule II.B affiliates.
