Subject: Second Supplement - Modify Energy Resource Recovery Account to record and recover the costs associated with RPS compliance requirements.

PURPOSE

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) a second supplemental filing for Advice 3023-E, originally dated March 30, 2007. The first supplemental filing was made via Advice 3023-E-A, dated July 18, 2007 in response to an Energy Division (ED) letter dated June 4, 2007. More recently, the ED on November 29, 2007, telephonically requested a clarifying update to PG&E's prior response to question #2. Specifically, it involves elaborating on the volumetric fee for WREGIS participation. The original question with the updated response follows.

1. *List the cost and fee categories associated with participation in WREGIS.*

PG&E clarifies the cost and fee categories associated with the use of WREGIS. While the overall fee structure remains the same for the annual fee of \$1,500, the volumetric fee will be based on WREGIS *issuance, transfer and retirement* fees as applicable. The table below summarizes the current WREGIS fees and fee categories. Please note that fees are subject to change and additional costs associated with WREGIS participation may arise in the future.
