Purpose:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") hereby submits to the Commission a supplemental filing to Advice Letter 3233-E dated March 19, 2008. The purpose of this supplement is to submit PG&E's Electricity and Gas Hedging Plan, Appendix B, of its Conformed 2006 Long-Term Procurement Plan ("Conformed 2006 LTPP").

Background:

Pursuant to Decision ("D.") 07-12-052, PG&E submitted its Conformed 2006 LTPP on March 19, 2008 for Commission review and approval. At the time of that advice filing, PG&E was finalizing internal approval of the Electricity and Gas Hedging Plan ("Hedging Plan") and it reserved space in its Conformed 2006 LTPP to insert the Hedging Plan later.

Today, PG&E respectfully submits its Hedging Plan, Appendix B, in accordance with the Commission's directives under D.07-12-052. PG&E has reviewed the revised Hedging Plan with the Energy Division and the Procurement Review Group. Attachments A and B are new cover sheets for Appendix B in the public versions of PG&E's Conformed 2006 LTPP. Attachments C and D are red-line and clean confidential versions of PG&E's Conformed 2006 LTPP.

Confidential Information:

The Hedging Plan is confidential in its entirety. The Hedging Plan was included in PG&E's amended 2006 LTPP filing made on March 5, 2007 which was

protected under ALJ Carol Brown's May 2nd order¹ approving PG&E's Motion to File Under Seal. As such, the Hedging Plan remains confidential pursuant to ALJ Carol Brown's May 2nd order.
