Purpose

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC or Commission) a supplemental advice filing for Advice 3256-E, dated April 22, 2008. The purpose of this supplement is to revise electric rate Schedule E-AMDS – Experimental Access to Meter Data Services, as shown in Attachment 1. This rate schedule was previously submitted in Advice 3256-E.

Proposed Rate Schedule

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph 11 of D.06-07-027 (“Decision”) issued July 20, 2006, approving PG&E’s Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Application (A.05-06-028 or “Application”), as modified in the Decision, and further instructions from the Commission’s Energy Division, PG&E hereby submits electric Schedule E-AMDS – Experimental Access to Meter Data Services as an experimental rate Schedule. The Schedule is shown in Attachment 1. The first service being offered in the rate Schedule is customer access to their electric energy usage through PG&E’s website.

Under the new service, a customer connected to PG&E’s SmartMeter™ System will be able to view, print, and download their electric energy usage through “My Account” at www.pge.com. This service is being offered at no cost to the customer.

This service will be available on or about July 1, 2008. Customers on the SmartMeter™ System will have access to the current day’s electric energy usage on the following day.

Based on instructions from the Energy Division, this schedule is being offered as an experimental schedule while the presentment of customer data continues to be under development. PG&E plans to submit a separate advice filing prior to the expiration date of the schedule. The proposed expiration date is October 31, 2008 or until cancelled by the CPUC.

A new release is scheduled for September 2008 which will provide up to 13 months of data retrieved from the SmartMeter™ system with usages as early as May 2008.
2. Data shown in "My Account" is not yet synchronized with the billing usage used in the customer's monthly bill. The monthly bill will contain the most updated and accurate usage information at the time the bill is created. (N)
