Subject: Request to File New Streetlight Application for Service

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby requests approval for new Form 79-1107, Streetlight Application for Service. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to create a new form, *Streetlight Application for Service*, which will be used by PG&E customers with stand alone street light requests. This new form enables PG&E to standardize, simplify and improve how PG&E processes stand alone streetlight requests from its customers. PG&E anticipates an increase in the number of stand alone streetlight requests from customers for Flood Light Installations.

Previously, customers were asked to either complete a Commercial/Industrial Development Application or a Residential Subdivision Development Application for these types of requests. Both of these applications require PG&E customers to provide information which is not required for stand alone streetlight requests but was required information based upon the application being completed.

This new form will give PG&E customers multiple options when requesting stand along streetlights. Customers can call the New Construction Service Center and apply over the phone, complete a hard copy form and send it to the New Construction Service Center or walk into a PG&E Service Planning Local Office to have their request processed.

If the city/county does not accept ownership of the street lights or ownership is submitted in the name of a Home Owners Association, the applicant will have to apply for the LS-3 rate schedule. The LS-1 or OL-1 rates can be requested for street lights that are located on private property.*
