Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to its gas and electric tariff form. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

Purpose

PG&E submits this advice letter to revise Form 62-0980, *Distribution Service and Extension Agreement-Declarations*, to update the accuracy of the form and make it more informative for PG&E customers.

Background

Currently Item 2 (Applicable Documents) of Form 62-0980 incorrectly refers to the cost summary that is part of PG&E's standard Service and Extension Agreement as Exhibit B. By this advice letter PG&E makes the correction to reference the accurate Exhibit. In addition, Item 2 also references two of PG&E's forms, *Provisions* and *General Terms and Conditions for Gas and Electric Service by Applicant*, but does not provide the form numbers associated with these documents. Form numbers for these documents should be provided in order to assist the applicant in reviewing the package of documents that make up the service and extension agreement. PG&E updates Form 62-0980 by adding in the form number for each respective referenced form.

Proposal

PG&E, by this filing, proposes that the following changes be made to Form 62-0980:

- that Exhibit "B" in the first sentence of Item 2 be changed to Exhibit "A"
- that the form number for the document *Provisions*- be inserted in parenthesis right after the word *Provisions* (Form 62-0982-) as here and
- that the form number for the document *General Terms and Conditions for Gas and Electric Service by Applicant* be inserted in parenthesis right after the document's name as here *General Terms and Conditions for Gas and Electric Service by Applicant* (Form 79-716)
