Purpose

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC or Commission) a request to extend the experimental status of rate schedule E-AMDS – *Experimental Access to Meter Data Services* to in order to provide additional time to analyze the data in PG&E's customer web presentment system.

Background

On April 22, 2008, in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 11 of Decision (D.) 06-07-027 issued July 20, 2006, PG&E submitted to Energy Division Advice 3256-E requesting approval of electric Schedule E-AMDS. On July 1, 2008, in accordance with Energy Division directives, PG&E submitted Advice 3256-E-A proposing to make schedule E-AMDS an experimental schedule. On July 10, 2008, Energy Division approved the experimental program through October 31, 2008.

Under this experimental service, a customer connected to PG&E's SmartMeter™ System is able to view, print, and download their electric energy usage through "My Account" at www.pge.com. This service is being offered at no cost to the customer.

Proposed Rate Schedule Revision

In order to allow both PG&E and the Energy Division additional time to thoroughly analyze the available data in PG&E's customer web presentment system, PG&E proposes to extend the experimental status of this program to December 31, 2008.
