for the Construction of the Kern-Stockdale 115 Kilovolt Relocation  
Project in the City of Bakersfield, County of Kern**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E" or "the Company") hereby submits notice pursuant to General Order (G.O.) 131-D, Section XI, Subsection B.4, of the construction of facilities that are exempt from a Permit to Construct.

**Purpose**

This advice letter provides a copy of the Notice of Proposed Construction (Attachment I) and the Notice Distribution List, which comply with the noticing requirements found in G.O. 131-D, Section XI.

**Background**

The Company has been requested by the developer of a new Jack-in-the-Box to relocate one pole in the existing Kern-Stockdale 115kilovolt Power Line within a franchise located in the City of Bakersfield, Kern County. The power line will be relocated into a new franchise location and will allow improvements to be made to Brundage Lane to accommodate the fast-food restaurant to be located on the south side of Brundage Lane approximately 200 feet east of Oswell Street. The Company will replace one existing 70-foot tall wood pole with a new light-duty steel pole roughly 10 feet taller (to clear the existing signal light) in a new location approximately 25 feet to the south (minor relocation). In addition, the Company will be installing two new stub pole and guy appurtenances to support the new angles in the power line. Each guy will span across Brundage Lane and attach to a stub pole. Work will commence in March 2010, or as soon thereafter as possible, and will be completed by April 2010, or as soon thereafter as possible.

CPUC General Order 131-D, Section III, Subsection B.1.c, exempts projects meeting specific conditions from the CPUC's requirement to file an application requesting authority to construct. The Company believes this project qualifies for the following exemption:

- c) The minor relocation of existing power line facilities up to 2,000 feet in length, or the intersetting of additional support structures between existing support structures.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other rate schedule or rule.

### **Protests**

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by filing a protest with the CPUC and the Company by **March 3, 2010**, which is 20 days after the date of this filing. Protests should be mailed to the following address:

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION

**PROJECT NAME: Kern-Stockdale 115 Kilovolt Power Line Relocation Project - City of Bakersfield**  
**ADVICE LETTER NUMBER: 3615-E**

**Proposed Project:** Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) has been requested by the developer of a new Jack-in-the-Box to relocate one pole in the existing Kern-Stockdale 115 kilovolt Power Line within a franchise located in the City of Bakersfield, Kern County. The power line will be relocated into a new franchise location and will allow improvements to be made to Brundage Lane to accommodate the fast-food restaurant to be located on the south side of Brundage Lane approximately 200 feet east of Oswell Street. PG&E will replace one existing 70-foot tall wood pole with a new light-duty steel pole roughly 10 feet taller (to clear the existing signal light) in a new location approximately 25 feet to the south (minor relocation). In addition, PG&E will be installing two new stub pole and guy appurtenances to support the new angles in the power line. Each guy will span across Brundage Lane and attach to a stub pole. Work will commence in March 2010, or as soon thereafter as possible, and will be completed by April 2010, or as soon thereafter as possible.

**Exemption from CPUC Permit Requirement:** CPUC General Order 131-D, Section III. B.1, exempts projects meeting specific conditions from the CPUC's requirement to file an application requesting authority to construct. Pacific Gas and Electric Company believes this project qualifies for the following exemption:

- c) The minor relocation of existing power line facilities up to 2,000 feet in length, or the intersetting of additional support structures between existing support structures.

**Public Review Process:** Persons or groups may protest the proposed construction if they believe that Pacific Gas and Electric Company has incorrectly applied for an exemption or that the conditions set out in Section III.B.2 of General Order 131-D exist;

- a. There is reasonable possibility that the activity may have an impact on an environmental resource of hazardous or critical concern where designated, precisely mapped and officially adopted pursuant to law by federal, state, or local agencies; or
- b. The cumulative impact of successive projects of the same type in the same place, over time, is significant; or
- c. There is a reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances.

Protests should include the following:

- 1. Your name, mailing address and daytime telephone number.
- 2. Reference to the CPUC Advice Letter Number and Project Name.
- 3. A clear description of the reason for the protest.
- 4. Whether you believe that evidentiary hearings are necessary to resolve factual disputes.
