Subject: Notification of the Creation of a New Affiliate

Purpose

In accordance with Decision 06-12-029, Appendix A, Rule VI.B--New Affiliate Compliance Plans, Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby notifies the Commission of the formation of new affiliates and re-designation of an affiliate under Rule II.B of the Affiliate Transaction Rules.

Rule VI. B. specifically requires that:

Upon creation of a new affiliate, which is addressed by these Rules, the utility shall immediately notify the Commission of the creation of the new affiliate, as well as posting notice on its electronic bulletin board. No later than 60 days after the creation of this affiliate, the utility shall file an advice letter with the Energy Division of the Commission, served on parties to this proceeding. The advice letter shall demonstrate how the utility will implement these Rules with respect to the new affiliate.

**Pacific Energy Capital II, LLC
Pacific Energy Capital III, LLC
Pacific Energy Capital IV, LLC**

Pacific Energy Capital II, LLC, Pacific Energy Capital III, LLC, and Pacific Energy Capital IV, LLC, were formed to establish and manage a portfolio of passive financial investments in growing energy companies. All three entities are Rule II.B. affiliates.

Pacific Energy Capital III, LLC, and Pacific Energy Capital IV, LLC, are formed but not yet active.

Pacific Energy Capital II, LLC is the investment entity for SunRun Pacific Solar, LLC, a new Rule II.B. affiliate of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, which was announced on June 2, 2010. SunRun Pacific Solar, LLC, is a tax equity project financing agreement to fund SunRun Inc's new home solar installations across the nation. The investment is funded by PG&E Corporation shareholders through Pacific Energy Capital II, LLC. Under the agreement, Pacific Energy Capital II, LLC, will provide financing for the rooftop energy systems and both parties will receive payments from SunRun customers. SunRun will manage the projects.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company will provide further details about SunRun Pacific Solar, LLC, in an advice letter due later this month.

Additional Information

PG&E Corporation also changed the name of Pacific Venture Capital, LLC, to Pacific Energy Capital I, LLC. Pacific Energy Capital I, LLC, is a Rule II.B. affiliate and has not changed its business description.

No unusual or unique circumstances exist that would require special affiliate transactions rule implementation measures.
