Subject: Clean-Up of Electric Preliminary Statement Part CP

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (“PG&E”) hereby submits for filing revisions to its electric tariffs. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment 1.

Purpose

This advice filing consolidates electric tariff changes resulting from the approval received on Advice 3909-E, “Modification of Energy Resource Recovery Account (ERRA) Preliminary Statement to Recover Net Surplus Compensation Payments to Eligible Net Energy Metering Customers Pursuant to Decision (D.)11-06-016 and Resolution E-4422.”

Background

Approval of Advice 3909-E effective October 24, 2011, received on March 1, 2012, requires incorporating approved new text into the existing Preliminary Statement CP, “Energy Resource Recovery Account.”
