Subject: Clean-Up of Electric Preliminary Statements

Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") hereby submits for filing revisions to its electric tariffs. The affected electric preliminary statements are listed in the enclosed Attachment 1.

Purpose

The purpose of this advice letter is to retire the following electric preliminary statements from PG&E's tariffs relating to the following regulatory accounts that are no longer necessary:

1. Preliminary Statement Part AE: Generation Divestiture Transaction Costs Memorandum Account
2. Preliminary Statement Part FZ: Virtual Net Energy Metering Site Assessment Memorandum Account

Background

1. Preliminary Statement Part AE: Generation Divestiture Transaction Costs Memorandum Account (GDTCMA)

The GDTCMA was established to record transaction costs incurred by PG&E associated with the divestiture of PG&E's generation facilities that was undertaken in accordance with AB 1890, the Electric Utility Industry Restructuring Act; Decision (D.) 95-12-063, as modified by D.96-01-009; and D.03-02-028. Specifically, the GDTCMA recorded divestiture transaction costs that included but were not limited to, investment banker fees and commissions, environmental impact reports and audits, outside legal support for regulatory proceedings and sales negotiations.

Electric Utility Industry Restructuring ended on January 18, 2001 with the enactment of California Assembly Bill 6X and the last of the account balance was recovered in 2008 in accordance with D.07-05-026. Because the account no longer has purpose, PG&E requests the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC or Commission) approval to close this account, and retire its Electric Preliminary Statement Part AE from its tariffs.

2. Preliminary Statement Part FZ: Virtual Net Energy Metering Site Assessment Memorandum Account (VNEMMA)

The VNEMMA was established in Advice Letter 4055-E-A to track costs incurred by PG&E for on-site Virtual Net Energy Metering (NEMV) assessments needed for complex service configurations, as directed by Resolution E-4481. These expenses were to be tracked through April 19, 2013 (one year from the issuance of Resolution E-4481), or as otherwise directed by the Commission. Subsequent to tracking these costs, PG&E is able to request recovery of these expenses through a separate filing with the Commission.

Through PG&E's efforts in modifying the application forms and working with our customers to collect the necessary technical details from NEMV interconnection applications, PG&E minimized the need for on-site assessments for NEMV. Out of 21 NEMV applications, PG&E only needed on-site assessments for 5 NEMV applications within this one year timeframe. Because the account no longer appears to be needed, PG&E requests the Commission's approval to close this account, and retire Electric Preliminary Statement Part FZ from its tariffs.
