**ADVICE 2212-G-A**

Public Utilities Commission of the State of California

Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to its gas tariffs. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

Advice 2212-G filed on February 9, 2000, proposes to revise Form 79-866—Gas Transmission Service Agreement (GTSA) Section 7—Assignment, to clarify assignment provisions for PG&E and for Customers. No other sections of the GTSA are being revised. The tariffs in this supplemental filing replace and supersede in toto the tariffs submitted in Advice 2212-G.

Current Affiliate Rules preclude assignment of interest by PG&E to an affiliate, except as set forth in the Affiliate Rules. At the request of the Commission's Energy Division, in this filing PG&E is removing the reference to "a parent or affiliate of PG&E" from the currently effective GTSA Assignment provisions. Energy Division also recommends that PG&E reinstate the provision from current GTSA Section 7 which provides that PG&E cannot assign its interest in the GTSA without the Customer's written consent.

This filing will not affect any other rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other rate schedule or rule.

PG&E requests that this filing be approved effective **March 20, 2000**, which is the approval date requested in Advice 2212-G. No protests were received to Advice 2212-G.
