Subject: Amended Affiliate Rules Compliance Plan

Purpose

In accordance with Rule VI.A. of the Commission's Affiliate Rules (adopted in Decision (D.) 98-08-035), Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby submits an updated Affiliate Rules Compliance Plan (Compliance Plan). The Compliance Plan and its attachments are attached to this filing.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company most recently updated the Compliance Plan by Advice 2202-G-A/1947-E-A, dated June 28, 2000. Changes to the Compliance Plan submitted herein include updates to reflect changes to the list of shared officers and directors, to update the description of on-going Utility training, and to update the list of entities within the PG&E Corporation family that meet the definition for affiliate provided in Rule !A.

This filing will not increase any other rate or change, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

PG&E requests that this filing become effective on **January 1, 2001**.
