Subject: Update of Service Provider Lists

Purpose

As directed in Affiliate Rule IV.C.2, (Decision 98-11-007), Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby submits its semi-annual update of its lists of service providers that contain affiliates. Pacific Gas and Electric Company requests authorization to continue to offer the following lists to customers, which contains one or more affiliates of Pacific Gas and Electric Company.¹ These lists were most recently approved effective June 11, 2001, in Advice 2315-G/2109-E.
