Subject: Amended Affiliate Rules Compliance Plan

Purpose

In accordance with Rule VI.A. of the Commission's Affiliate Rules (adopted in Decision (D.) 98-08-035), Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby submits an updated Affiliate Rules Compliance Plan (Compliance Plan). The Compliance Plan and its attachments are attached to this filing.¹

Pacific Gas and Electric Company most recently updated the Compliance Plan by Advice 2287-G/2067-E, dated December 29, 2000. Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby submits for filing amended sections of its compliance plan. The amended sections are Rule V, Attachments A, B, D, and Exhibit G of Attachment E. Pacific Gas and Electric Company is filing these amendments to: 1) reflect changes to the list of shared officers and directors; 2) update the description of on-going Utility training and policy memos; 3) update the list of entities within the PG&E Corporation family that meet the definition for affiliate provided in Rule IA; and 4) clarify the performance incentive plan process for employees who transfer between the Utility and PG&E Corporation.

This filing will not increase any other rate or change, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter within 20 days of the date of this filing. The protest must state the grounds upon which it
