Subject: Revisions to Agreement for Supply of Natural Gas for Compression as a Motor-Vehicle Fuel (Form No. 79-755)

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to its gas tariffs. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.¹

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to revise **PG&E's Agreement for Supply of Natural Gas for Compression as a Motor-Vehicle Fuel (Form No. 79-755)**, including new Exhibit A for customer communications.

Background

PG&E's experimental natural gas vehicle program was established in 1991 to offer compressed natural gas (CNG) service to existing Natural Gas Vehicle (NGV) markets. The sale of fuel by utilities for NGV use is a fully-regulated activity under Commission jurisdiction. PG&E implemented its program to increase NGV use in its own car fleets by installing fueling facilities at several PG&E service centers.

Tariff Revisions

PG&E proposes the following modifications to Form 79-755:

1. Modify the Compressed Natural Gas Agreement (Form 79-755) to update the distribution list at the top of the first page.
2. Insert a new Section 3 to indicate the attachment of new Exhibit A, applicable PG&E gas rules, and rate schedules.

3. Delete Section 5, regarding gas treatment procedures, from the original agreement because current NGVs operate within the range of PG&E current pipeline composition.
4. Delete Section 7 on taxes from the original agreement because it is incorporated in the NGV1 rate schedule.
5. Move the Customer's billing address in Section 9 of the original agreement to Exhibit A.
6. Change the initial term in Section 10, now Section 9, to 12 months and the commencement date to the day the Customer's gas meter is installed.
7. Modify Section 11 and 12, now Section 10, to include communication through electronic mail or internet messages, and move the address information and instructions for formal communication to Exhibit A.
8. Insert new Section 11, concerning Rights to Data, because the rate is experimental and PG&E will review the data.
9. Include new Exhibit A (NGV Customer Communication) where customer information, contacts, and electronic mail addresses are aggregated in a more convenient format.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter within 20 days from the date of this filing, which is **September 12, 2002**. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. Protests should be mailed to:
