Public Utilities Commission of the State of California

**Subject: Notification of the Creation of Two New Affiliates**

**Purpose**

In accordance with Decision 97-12-088, Appendix A, Rule VI. B--New Affiliate Compliance Plans, Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby notifies the Commission of the formation of two new affiliates, as defined by the Affiliate Transaction Rules.<sup>1</sup>

Rule VI. B. Specifically requires that:

Upon creation of a new affiliate, which is addressed by these Rules, the utility shall immediately notify the Commission of the creation of the new affiliate, as well as posting notice on its electronic bulletin board. No later than 60 days after the creation of this affiliate, the utility shall file an advice letter with the Energy Division of the Commission, served on parties to this proceeding. The advice letter shall demonstrate how the utility will implement these Rules with respect to the new affiliate.

Moss Landing Mutual Water Company was formed on April 1, 1998, as a non-profit public mutual benefit corporation to sell, distribute, supply and deliver water to members of the corporation only for domestic uses, irrigation uses, and fire protection uses. Pacific Gas and Electric Company described the formation of the two mutual water companies in Application 96-11-020 which the Commission subsequently approved in Decision 97-09-046. At the time these entities were formed, Pacific Gas and Electric Company was not aware that these non-profit entities could be considered "affiliates", the formation of which might trigger notification requirements under the then newly-adopted Commission Affiliate Rules.

Moss Landing Mutual Water Company and Morro Bay Mutual Water Company will not provide an energy related good or service, therefore the affiliate rules will not apply to these affiliates. Pacific Gas and Electric Company will not apply all the provisions of its Affiliate Rules Compliance Plan to transactions with these Non-Rule II.B. affiliates and will treat them in the same manner as it does PG&E Corporation and other Non-Rule II.B. affiliates.
