**Subject: Application Form – Request for Service**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submit this filing for revisions to its gas and electric tariffs. The affected tariff sheets are listed in Attachment I.

**Purpose**

Many of PG&E's property managers have indicated that they have concerns that when a tenant commences occupancy, the property manager has no way of assuring that the tenant will place service in his or her name. By having the application for service filled out in the property manager's office and faxed directly to PG&E, the property manager will then know that the service is in fact going to be taken out of the name of the landlord.

This form will save the property manager's time. The fax application will be helpful when there are numerous tenants commencing occupancy contemporaneously. The associated time required to follow-up with new tenants will be reduced since this form will ensure that the property owner's name has been removed from the utility service and has been transferred into the name of the new tenant.

PG&E will also send follow-up rate option information to the new tenant, so, if a tenant desires alternate rates, this information will be available shortly after the establishment of service.

However, to clarify, PG&E is not modifying the Interim Service Agreement, but simply re-instating the Request for Service form, which the property manager can have the tenants execute to ensure that the service does not remain in the name of the landlord, after the tenant has assumed occupancy.
