**Subject: New Form 79-1018—Residential Rule 16 Electric/Gas  
Single Service Extensions**

Public Utilities Commission of the State of California

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing new Form 79-1018—Residential Rule 16 Electric/Gas Single Service Extensions, for its gas and electric line extension tariffs for certain single services under Rule 16--Electric/Gas Service Extensions. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

**Purpose**

PG&E receives approximately 10,000 applications per year for new business gas and/or electric single residential Rule 16 services; that is, service to a single new home that does not require any associated new distribution (Rule 15) facilities. Since in many cases the applicant for the service connection is an individual homeowner, and the service work is relatively inexpensive and simple, a vast majority of these applicants request that PG&E design and install the services.

PG&E's current, multi-paged line extension contract forms treat these simple Rule 16 single service projects and the much more complicated Rule 15 and 16 residential, subdivision, and non-residential projects the same. The current line extension forms consist of Form 62-0980—Electric/Gas Distribution Service and Extension Agreement--Declarations (2 pages), Form 62-0982—Distribution and Service Extension Agreement--Provisions (approximately 8 pages), Form 79-1003--Statement of Applicant's Contract Anticipated Costs (2 pages), and Form 79-1004—Distribution and Service Extension Agreement—Exhibit A Cost Summary (approximately 10 pages for two commodities), for a total number of approximately 22 pages, not including copies of any applicable rules.

By this filing, PG&E proposes a new, simplified, and easier to understand two-page letter agreement to be used for specified single residential Rule 16 services.

**Background**

Electric Rule 16.A.8 provides in part that, "Each Applicant requesting service may be required to execute a written contract(s)...". Such contract(s) shall be in the form on file with the [Commission]." Gas Rule 16.A.7 contains similar language.

PG&E's existing line extension contract forms cover, without distinction, various applicants, including residential and non-residential, and combinations of the two; Rule 15 and 16 combined, and Rule 15 and 16 alone; single family homes and subdivisions; sophisticated builders of commercial developments, commercial and residential units; and individual, first-time homeowners. The existing contract forms also cover relocation/rearrangement of PG&E facilities.

Therefore, PG&E is proposing a shortened and simplified letter agreement form when all the following conditions are met:

1. The application is only for a residential gas and/or electric Rule 16 service;
2. The application is for a single service for each commodity;
3. The applicant indicates on its Application for Service that it wants PG&E to design and install the project; and
4. No new Rule 15 distribution facilities are part of the project; consequently, there is no refundable advance by Applicant.

Confining the new letter agreement to single residential Rule 16 jobs, and jobs where the costs are non-refundable under the current rules (e.g., PG&E does the work, and no Rule 15 facilities are involved) is necessary to avoid projects where PG&E would have to track potential refunds over time, and that would, in turn, require PG&E's more complex line extension forms and procedures.

**Form 79-1018—Residential Rule 16 Electric/Gas Single Service Extensions**

The key components of new Form 79-1018 include:

- Limitation of service to a single residence, with a single service for each commodity;
- Design and installation performed by PG&E;
- Incorporation of Rule 16 by reference, and available on PG&E's website ([www.pge.com/tariffs](http://www.pge.com/tariffs)) and from the local Service Planning Office (phone number included);

- An itemization of costs;
- Explanation of, and attachment of, Form 79-1003--Statement of Applicant's Contract Anticipated Costs. (If the applicant, after seeing PG&E's cost estimates desires to undertake the project, it would be allowed to do so);
- A 90-day limitation on PG&E's cost estimates.

### Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter by **August 25, 2004**, which is 20 days from the date of this filing. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. Protests should be mailed to:

This letter describes the costs for new gas and/or electric service to your residence at the above address. PG&E will provide the service under the provisions of PG&E's Gas and/or Electric Rule 16, as authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), which rule(s) is incorporated by reference. A copy of Rule 16 can be obtained at [www.pge.com/tariffs](http://www.pge.com/tariffs) or by contacting your PG&E representative at the number shown on the second page. PG&E's total estimated job costs are shown on the cost summary, also on the second page.

Enclosed is a CPUC-required form, "Statement of Applicant's Contract Anticipated Costs," (SACAC) which identifies PG&E's cost for the refundable service work that is PG&E's responsibility to install on your job. PG&E's costs were developed based on your choices within the application and may change if you change your choices. Under PG&E's Gas and/or Electric Rule 16, you, the Applicant, have a choice: you can do the work, hire a qualified contractor to perform the work or hire PG&E to do the work. You must return the completed SACAC form to PG&E regardless of who does the work.

- If you want to do this work yourself, or to have a qualified contractor do this work, please enter your estimated costs in the section of the SACAC form entitled "Applicant Costs," sign it, return it to PG&E, and PG&E will send you a contract by return mail.
- If you want to do this work yourself or have a qualified contractor do it, and you do not want to give PG&E your estimated costs, please check the box in the section entitled "Applicant's Election Not To Provide Costs," sign, return the SACAC form, and PG&E will send you a contract by return mail.
- If you want PG&E to do this work, check the section "Applicant's Election Not To Provide Costs," sign and return the SACAC form along with a check for \$ \_\_\_\_\_. This letter will be our contract.<sup>1</sup> PG&E will schedule construction upon receipt of payment, and written confirmation from the governmental entity with inspection authority that your facilities have been installed and inspected in accordance with applicable laws, and are safe to energize/pressurize.

PG&E's costs are valid for 90 days from the date of this letter. If payment is not received within this 90-day period, PG&E may revise these costs.
