Public Utilities Commission of the State of California

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing new Form 79-1026—*Authorization to Revise Nominating Marketers on Exhibits C and D of Form 79-756—Natural Gas Service Agreement* (NGSA). The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

Purpose

New Form 79-1026 provides a means for customers to request that PG&E revise Exhibits C and/or D of NGSA Form 79-756. By using this form, customers can add or revise suppliers and/or delete former suppliers from Exhibits C and/or D of their NGSA. Customers may also indicate whether or not they wish to permit Nominating Marketers to have access to gas metering data, view contract quantities shown on NGSA Exhibit B, or authorize imbalance trades, as specified in Schedule G-BAL. Customers also can indicate whether or not they wish Nominating Marketers to receive bill copies, imbalance statements or OFO/EFO Notices.¹ Form 79-1026 provides a faster, more convenient way for customers to request changes to their NGSA.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter by **February 14, 2005**, which is 20 days from the date of this filing. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. Protests should be mailed to:


