**Subject: Supplement to 2007 Natural Gas Public Purpose Program  
Surcharges Advice Letter**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits updated gas public purpose program (PPP) surcharge rates to be effective January 1, 2007. The final PPP rates are shown in Table I and in Attachment 1 to this filing.

**Purpose**

In accordance with Gas PPP Decision (D.) 04-08-010 and Energy Division instruction, PG&E submits this supplement to Advice 2769-G to revise the California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) administration amount included in PPP rates in order to reflect the most recently-adopted budget. The CARE administration amount presented herein is \$79,000 less than that filed in Advice 2769-G. PG&E also submits the final tariff for Schedule GPPPS - *Gas Public Purpose Program Surcharge* and the final gas PPP rates for Preliminary Statement B incorporating this revision, as shown in Attachment 1.

**Background**

In accordance with Public Utilities Code Sections 890-900 and Gas PPP Surcharge D.04-08-010, PG&E updated its natural gas PPP surcharge rates for 2007 to fund authorized energy efficiency (EE), low-income energy efficiency (LIEE), CARE and public-interest Research, Development and Demonstration (RD&D) programs through Advice 2769-G on October 31, 2006.

As part of that advice letter, PG&E included a proposed CARE administration amount of \$2,689,000 in gas PPP rates for 2007, per PG&E's outstanding

Application 06-03-034.<sup>1</sup> Upon further discussion with Energy Division and review of D.04-08-010, PG&E concludes that PPP rates for 2007 should be calculated using “most recently-adopted PPP budgets” (D.04-08-010, p.6). The most recently-adopted CARE administration amount allocated to gas customers is \$2,610,000, per D.05-04-052, which is \$79,000 less than the amount included in Advice 2769-G. As a result of this revision, the PPP rates for non-CARE customers presented here are 0.002 cents/therm lower than those originally presented in Advice 2769-G. CARE customers do not pay CARE administration costs and therefore, will not be affected by this revision.

Accordingly, PG&E submits this supplement to revise the CARE administration amount included in PPP rates for 2007, as shown in Table I and Attachment 1 of this filing. In accordance with D.04-08-010, PG&E will not be revising PPP rates to reflect final revenue requirements adopted for 2007 between October 31, 2006 and the end of the year, unless authorized to do so by the Commission.

### **Effective Date**

Pursuant to D.04-08-010, PG&E requests that this advice filing become effective on **January 1, 2007**.

<sup>1</sup> PG&E also proposed an LIEE budget for 2007-2008 in the application as later revised on September 12, 2006; however, the LIEE budget proposed for 2007 is the same as the most-recently adopted LIEE budget in D.06-08-025. Accordingly, PG&E does not propose any revisions to the LIEE amount in this advice filing.



SCHEDULE G-PPPS—GAS PUBLIC PURPOSE PROGRAM SURCHARGE

**APPLICABILITY:** Pursuant to Public Utility (PU) Code Sections 890-900, this schedule applies a gas Public Purpose Program (PPP) surcharge to gas transportation volumes under the rate schedules\* specified below. The gas PPP surcharge is collected to fund gas energy efficiency and low-income energy efficiency programs, the California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) low-income assistant program, and public interest research and development. Under PU Code Section 896, certain customers are exempt from the gas PPP surcharge as described in the Exempt Customer section, below.

**TERRITORY:** This rate applies everywhere within PG&E's natural gas Service Territory.

**RATES:** The following surcharges apply to natural gas service for eligible Core and Noncore End-Use Customers.

- b. All gas consumed by Enhanced Oil Recovery (EOR) facilities;
- c. All gas consumed by customers in which the State of California is prohibited from taxing under the United States Constitution or the California Constitution, consistent with California Energy Resources Surcharge Regulations 2315 and 2316, as described in Publication No. 11 issued by the California State Board of Equalization (BOE), which include:
  - 1. The United States, its unincorporated agencies and instrumentalities;
  - 2. Any incorporated agency of instrumentality of the United States wholly owned by either the United States or by a corporation wholly owned by the United States;
  - 3. The American National Red Cross, its chapters and branches;
  - 4. Insurance companies, including title insurance companies, subject to taxation under California Constitution, Article XIII, Section 28, or its successor;
