Public Utilities Commission of the State of California

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to its gas tariffs. The affected tariff sheets are included in Attachment I to this filing.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to update PG&E's service area maps in Kern County, California. This filing is submitted in compliance with Decision (D) 62681 (dated 10/17/1961)¹ and Resolution (R.)G-3197 (dated 2/5/1997) in which the Commission ordered PG&E and Southern California Gas Company (SoCal Gas) to discuss and delineate their Kern County service areas, and file an advice letter including a revised service area map. PG&E and SoCal Gas have agreed on the revised service area boundaries in the attached maps.

This filing will not affect any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other rate schedule or rule.

Effective Date

PG&E requests that this advice filing become effective on regular notice, **June 17, 2007**, which is 30 calendar days after the date of this filing.

Protests

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter by **June 7, 2007**, which is 20 days from the date of this filing. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. Protests should be mailed to:


