Subject: Eliminate Form 79-865 - *Electric and Gas Monitoring Meter Pulse Agreement*

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby submits for filing revisions to its gas and electric tariff sheets. The affected tariff sheets are listed on the enclosed Attachment I.

Purpose

This filing proposes to eliminate Form 79-865 - *Electric and Gas Monitoring Meter Pulse Agreement*, which has been superseded by Form 79-1049.

Background

Form 79-865 - *Electric and Gas Monitoring Meter Pulse Agreement*, was approved in Advice 2130-G/1837-E on May 19, 1999, to provide customers with access to their meter data by receiving meter data pulses from their gas and/or electric meters. PG&E is now using Form 79-1049 - *Agreement to Install Applicant Requested Common Special Facilities*, to provide customers with meter data pulse services. Form 79-1049 was approved in Advice 2688-G/2755-E on January 11, 2006, and later revised in Advice 2890-G/3167-E. This agreement is used for the installation and collection of charges for "common" special facilities and is applicable to the installation of electric and gas meter pulse devices. As a result, PG&E has discontinued the use of Form 79-865 in favor of the more simple special facilities agreement.
