Here in the high deserts of San Bernardino County for a research and development project, PG&E is testing remote controlled Black Hawk helicopters that can dip and drop hundreds of gallons of water with the touch of a button.

This technology will assist with expanding the operational window to include night and on a trajectory in the future the ability to pre-position numerous aircraft throughout remote areas to reduce response times to catastrophic fires.

The reason we're down here is we're very much integrated as a utility in keeping on the front end of what's happening that can ensure that fires that do occur within our service territory get a very rapid response.
