Because the EQCSA is standardized, it ensures that everyone who wants to be considered receives a fair and objective opportunity. This assessment has been validated to ensure job relatedness. The EQCSA is a multiple choice assessment that covers the essential knowledge areas of the Electric Quality Control Specialist Assessment job.

The EQCSA is an online, proctored assessment that has 50 multiple choice questions and a time limit of 120 minutes. Please familiarize yourself with the following knowledge areas to prepare for the assessment:
